

**TOWN OF NOBLEFORD
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

BYLAW NO. 717

BEING a bylaw of the Town of Nobleford in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the rates of taxation to be levied against assessable property within the Town of Nobleford for the 2026 taxation year.

WHEREAS the Town of Nobleford has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of municipal revenue, expenses and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on February 10, 2026;

AND WHEREAS the estimated municipal expenditure (excluding non-cash items) set out in the annual budget for the Town of Nobleford for 2026 is \$3,455,120;

AND WHEREAS the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all other sources other than taxation are estimated at \$1,798,350; and the balance of \$1,656,770 is to be raised by general municipal property taxation;

AND WHEREAS the estimated amount to repay a principal debt to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$21,250;

AND WHEREAS the estimated amount required for current year capital expenditures to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$0.00;

AND WHEREAS the estimated amount required for future financial plans to be raised by municipal taxation is \$0.00;

THEREFORE, the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$931,130.

AND WHEREAS the requisitions are:

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Nobleford is authorized to classify assessed property and to establish different rates of taxation in respect of each class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000;

AND WHEREAS the assessed value of all property in the Town of Nobleford shown on the assessment roll is:

NOW THEREFORE, under authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 as amended, the Council of the Town of Nobleford, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of the Town of Nobleford:
